In 2012, she was recognized for the 40 Under 40 award by the National Center for American Indian Enterprise Development. Kristin received her M.S. degree with honors in Native American Leadership from Southeastern Oklahoma State University in the spring of 2020 and a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Oklahoma State University in 2009, where she graduated as a Senior of Significance.
