It is also home to the historic McSwain Theatre and is known for its vibrant Main Street and Arts District, and a variety of boutiques, eateries and attractions.

[McSwain Theatre](#)

The McSwain Theatre in Ada, Oklahoma has been in business for more than 90 years while bringing a wide variety of live entertainment to fans of all ages. Originally built in 1920, this theatre has seen several famous movie stars and musicians take the stage over its life span.

In 2002, the Chickasaw Nation purchased the McSwain Theatre and began to upgrade and restore much of its original, 1920's look. Currently, visitors can enjoy live music performances including country, rock, gospel and oldies as well as comedy shows and weekly movie nights on McSwain's big screen.

[Chickasaw Community Gardens](#)

The Chickasaw Community Gardens were created in March 2002 to fulfill their purpose of employing and training Chickasaw youth and adults. The program started very small with a single-bay greenhouse. Thalia Miller, the Director of the Chickasaw Nation Horticulture Department and overseer of the Community Gardens, has been able to grow and expand the program. They now have a dual-bay greenhouse, a raised garden and a traditional garden. The department now staffs 10 full-time adults, 6 youth workers year-round and 12 summer youth workers. Beyond these employment opportunities, the staff is able to participate in enrichment programs including etiquette classes, cultural activities, arts and crafts and guest speaking.

Vintage 22 Wine & Dessert Bar is Ada's very own upscale wine bar located in the cultural arts district. The menu features a list of fine wines, beers and specialty drinks.
